where we are delaying project starts into 2012. Some of those upcoming projects are ALSF Cable Replacement at Oceana NAS, Airfield Lighting Rehabilitation in Newport News, VA, Runway Rehabilitation in Huntington, WV, and our return to Wilmington for the Runway 6-24 PAPI installation.

Currently, Jim and Phil are preparing the crew for an MV cable replacement in Ft. Belvoir, VA. Jim has also been coordinating the temporary services and mobilization for Hillsborough WWTP. Will and Chad are scheduled to finish the Taxiway Turnaround project in Tarboro this week.
